The chart below shows the topics to be covered this half term. Please help your child's interest in their work by discussing the topics with them or taking them to the library etc. We ask all parents to assist children with reading, spelling and any homework that is provided by the teacher.

<u>Subject</u>	<u>Topic</u>
	Topic for Summer 1- Wriggle and crawl
English	Non-chronological report on mini-beasts, information leaflet, diary entries.
Maths	Position and direction, time and capacity.
RE	Eastertide
Science	Living things and habitats, animals including humans- basic needs of animals.
Music	Singing with Mr Kyle, Charanga music curriculum and playing an instrument (recorders) and reading music
PE	Ball handling, throwing and catching games
Art	Exploring work of famous artists and recreating these
Computing	Creating algorithms and creating and debugging simple programs
PSHCE	Relationships and friendship

Spellings and homework are given out on a Wednesday morning. The written homework will be related to English, Maths or Topic. This needs to be completed and handed in by Monday.

Our spelling test will be on a Monday morning and you will receive a slip informing you of your child's result each week.

PE is on Wednesday afternoon, could you please make sure your child has the correct PE kit of black/blue shorts and white t shirt. Your child can leave their PE kit in school and it will be sent home at the end of each half term.

Children need to have their book bags in school every day with their reading books and records so they can be checked and changed. Children need to read at least 5 times a week to move up the class reading wall and make good progress.
